S/N	OFFENCES	PENALTIES
1.	Bringing into the examination environment any unauthorized materials including jotted notes (scripts)	 Cancel all papers of the candidate at that particular examination. Suspend him/her from taking the examination for four (4) consecutive examination diets.
2.	Impersonation Usage of another Candidate's Login details to access the Examination	 (i) Impersonatee Cancel all papers of the candidate at that particular examination. Suspend the persons concerned from taking the Institute's Examinations for life. Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. Inform candidate's employers.
		 (ii) Impersonator (a) If a member Suspend the person concerned from taking the Institute's examinations for life Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. Inform candidate's employers.
		 (b) If not a member Hand over the affected person(s) to the Police.
3.	Forgery of Examination Dockets, Signatories on the docket and other means of Identification.	 Cancel all papers of the candidate at that particular examination. Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. Inform candidate's employers.
4.	Assistance from Individuals (mercenaries).	 a) i) The Person Being Assisted Cancel that particular paper Suspend him/her from taking the examination for four (4) consecutive examination diets. Inform candidate's employers.
		b) iii) Individual(Mercenaries) • Suspend the person concerned from taking the Institute's examinations for life • Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. • Inform candidate's employers. c) ii) If not a member • Forfeits invigilation honorarium. • Suspend from future invigilation. • Hand over the affected person(s) to the Police.

	Having prior knowledge of perpetration of exam misconduct and not escalating to the Institute immediately.	 (a) If a member Suspend the person concerned from taking the Institute's examinations for life Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. Inform candidate's employers. (b) If an Associate Report him/her to the Investigating Panel for investigation. Inform candidate's employers. (c) If not a member Hand over the affected person(s) to the Police. d) If a candidate Cancel all papers of the candidate at that particular examination. Suspend him/her from taking the examination for four (4) consecutive examination diets. Inform candidate's employers.
	Leaving your computer and test environment during the exam period	Cancel that particular paper.Give warning letter
-	Failure to adhere to the examination instructions by: improper environmental scan Sitting in a dark environment/ room with a poor lighting system obstruction of the camera Sighting of a third-party while the examination is ongoing. tampering with your computer to modify your testing space in a way that does not meet the examinations requirements.	 Cancel that particular paper. Give warning letter
	Any other established act of examination malpractice.	Other misconducts shall be treated on its merits by the sub-committee on the Review of Misconduct Cases.
